It was reported that there is uneven road surface at the entrance of The Botanical Gardens; this needs investigating by the local Authority.

LCC 18/139 COUNTY COUNCILLOR'S REPORT

County Councillor Mrs C. A. Davies confirmed the following:

Council Budget

Carmarthenshire County Council has set its revenue budget for the next financial year. Council tax will increase by 4.45 per cent to help the council meet the cost of providing public services, equating to a rise of less than £1 per week (£4.25 per month over the year), for an average Band D property.

Councillors met on Wednesday (February 21st 2018) to agree on the budget put forward by the executive board following consultation.

Plans to build new council homes

New social/ affordable housing will be built in Carmarthenshire over the next five years. The rent of council houses will increase by £1.50 per week.

Right of appeal for School Transport

A discussion was held regarding decisions not to award the provision of free school transport for children, parents have by law, have a right to appeal against that decision.

Local Development Plan 2018-2033

An LDP sets out proposals and policies for the future use of all local land, and is the main development plan document in Wales. The LDP covers a period of fifteen years and should reflect national planning policy in Wales. Carmarthenshire County Council held a meeting on the 10th of January, 2018 where it was resolved to prepare a revised LDP for Carmarthenshire. Once adopted the revised LDP will be used as the basis for deciding on planning applications.

Hywel Dda Health Plan

A major change to plans to health care across West Wales by Hywel Dda University Health Board sees six options to how health care will be delivered. There will be no A&E at Glangwili, with patients having to go to Prince Phillip Hospital. Glangwili will be demoted and part of the site sold off. In two of the options Glangwili would become a planned care hospital, where operations have been arranged.

In four of the options Glangwili would become an enhanced community hub offering day treatment such as dialysis, chemotherapy, day operations. In five of the options a brand new hospital would be built between Whitland and Narberth.

A decision could be made this September on the plans. No decisions will be taken until public consultation is taken and responses are taken into account. It was also brought to County Councillor C A Davies that the lack of parking spaces at Glangwili Hospital is a serious issue.

Cuppa with a Copper

County Councillor Mrs C A Davies reported how communities within Carmarthenshire are hosting a cup of coffee and chat on a weekly bases. This is

an opportunity for local residents and businesses to have a chat with their local police with the chance to discuss issues concerning them.

Llanarthne Village Hall

County Councillor Mrs C A Davies reported that Llanarthne Village Hall is celebrating it's tenth anniversary next month. This includes a celebration with Baldande and Huw Chiswell on the $14^{\rm th}$ of April, and a service in the Hall on the $15^{\rm th}$ of April, officiated by Rev. Desmond Davies and Rev. Canon Bryan Witt. Tickets can be purchased from County Councillor Mrs C A Davies.
